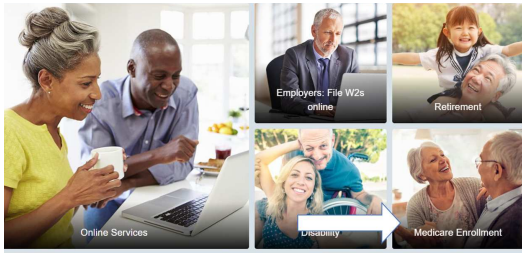

Scroll down about half way down the page until you see bright BLUE box that says "APPLY for MEDICARE ONLY- click on box"

Will need to create a MY SS account-
Save user ID and Password somewhere safe, you will receive an email code to verify it is you. Please confirm email address and use confirmation code to log in.

Fill in all Info requested-

****SELECT THAT you ARE STILL covered by Group coverage**

Have your employment dates available when completing the application.
KEEP THE RE_ENTRY number available until you receive your Medicare ID card

Please review the info you entered and the digitally sign the form by typing your name

COMPLETION! You will receive correspondence from SSA within approximately 2 weeks via snail mail. If they need any further info from you they will request it that letter, if not you will receive your Medicare card in about 2-4 weeks

The "My SS account" you created will have your Medicare number visible in it within 15-30 business days ..
